The week-long event officially became a month-long one in 1987 when Congress passed a resolution designating March as Women's History Month. 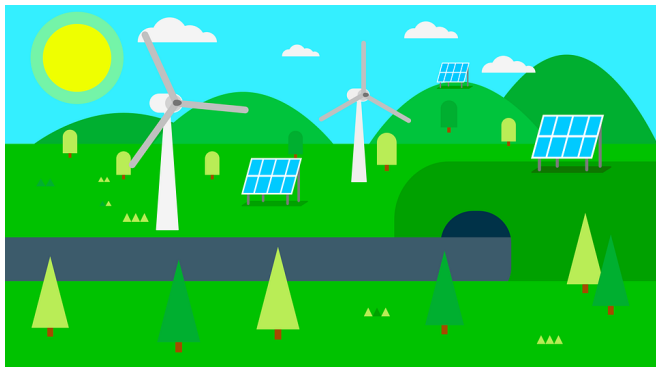
