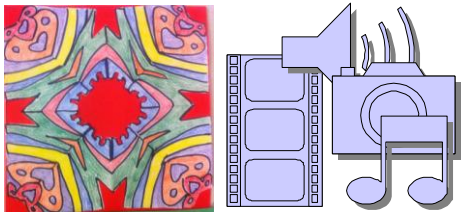
Reminder About Snack/Hot Lunch...

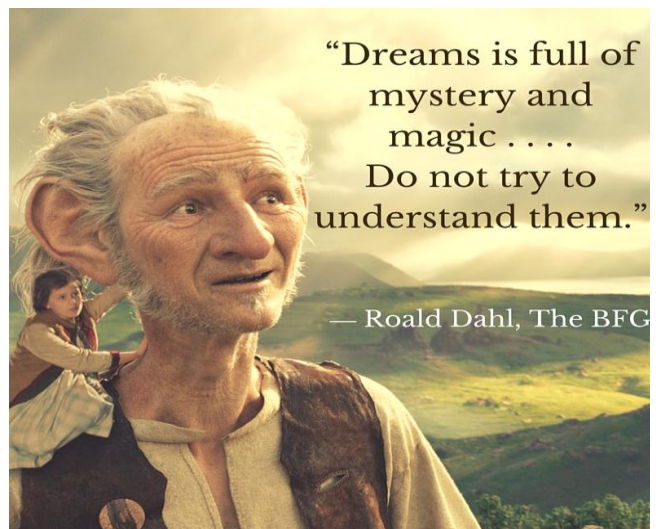
