first 5 multiples, and factor trees to your classmates. Teaching helps you understand concepts even better! We should be able to begin Chapter 1 Lesson 2 Ratios. My 7th graders are working on ratios again now. You will run into them forever!!

**READING/ENGLISH/SPELLING:** Look out for that “Current TFK magazine that pops up in Google Classroom at the beginning of every week. You took your first TFK quiz on Thursday or Friday last week. There will be a TFK quiz every Friday. Remember to read the entire magazine before you attempt the quiz. You will be able to ask me questions about parts of the quiz from the time it is posted until the day it is due.

We will be adding Power Words from each TFK magazine to your Quizlet Study Sets for future spelling tests. Be sure to add any of the words we encounter during our class discussions.
