- **Transitional** deacons are men who are preparing for the priesthood.
- Under the authority of the Pope, a bishop usually heads a **diocese**.
- In Holy Orders baptized men are ordained to serve the **Church** in a special way.
- The ministers of the Sacrament of Matrimony are **the man and woman**.
- Holy Orders and Matrimony are Sacraments **at the Service of Communion**.
- In the Sacrament of Matrimony the priest is the **official witness**.
- The ways we can serve God and the Church are called **vocations**.
- In Matrimony a baptized man and a baptized woman promise to be faithful to each other **for the rest of their lives**.
- Saint Philip Neri used **his sense of humor** to help lead people to God.
- Married men may be ordained to serve the Church as **permanent** deacons.
- A vocation is a call from God.
- Deacons are helpers of their bishop and of priests.
- Matrimony is the Sacrament of Marriage.
- A bishop ordains priests.
- Wedding rings are a sign of married couple's love and fidelity.
- What is the reason for the Sacrament of Matrimony? In the Sacrament of Matrimony, a baptized man and a baptized woman promise to love and be faithful to each other for the rest of their lives. They ask for God's blessing and give public witness of their love.
