2 Times Tables

$$2 \times 0 = 0$$

$$2 \times 1 = 2$$

$$2 \times 2 = 4$$

$$2 \times 3 = 6$$

$$2 \times 4 = 8$$

$$2 \times 5 = 10$$

$$2 \times 6 = 12$$

$$2 \times 7 = 14$$

$$2 \times 8 = 16$$

$$2 \times 9 = 18$$

$$2 \times 10 = 20$$

$$2 \times 11 = 22$$

Please review these times tables and help your child memorize them.

The children will **not** be allowed to use their blue times tables math sheet during testing. It may help you to use flash cards and quiz your child periodically. ****Remember, when you multiply by 2, you are simply doubling the number that you are multiplying.**

Example: 2×4 is the same as $4 + 4$
