We can live the virtue of chastity by **dressing modestly**.

The virtue of **temperance** helps us balance our lives.

The Theological Virtue of **Hope** helps us trust in God's promise of eternal life.

The Theological Virtue of **Faith** helps us believe in God and in the teachings of the Catholic Church.

Another word for the four central virtues that help us live a holy life is **Cardinal Virtues**.

The virtue of **justice** enables us to work for fair treatment of others.

God's greatest gift to us is **love**.

The virtue of **fortitude** helps us endure difficulties.

God gives us many good gifts so that we can grow in **holiness**.

When family members are kind, forgiving, generous, and loving, they are living as the **domestic church**.

A **virtue** is a good habit.

Scripture tells us that the greatest virtue is **love**.

The virtue of **chastity** helps us express our sexuality in the proper way.

Virtues in a Christian Life play many roles, such as...

- to discover God's will
- to seek God's guidance
- to express trust in God
- to discover our vocation
- to grow closer to God
- to grow in faith in God
- to grow in love of God and of other people, and so on...
