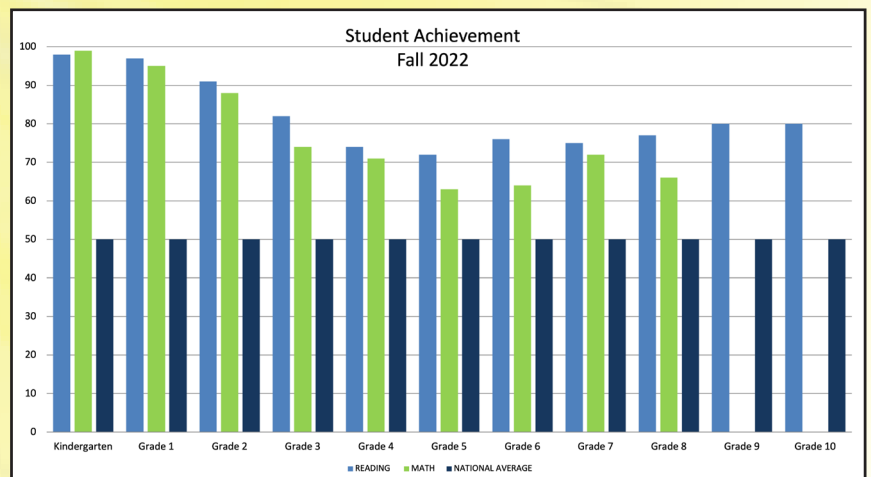
GOVERNANCE AND LEADERSHIP
